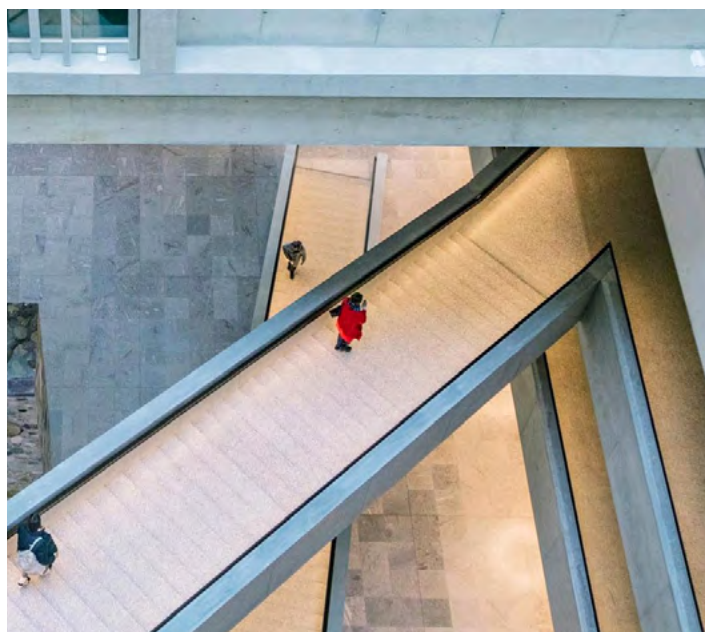

Terms and conditions of booking

1. Deadline for registration is set for September 1, 2025.
2. Acceptance of applications for sponsorship and exhibition is at the discretion of the organizers.

 - a. Cancellation more than 60 days prior to the first open day of the workshop – 100% reimbursement of the payments (no penalty).
 - b. Cancellation between 31 and 60 days prior to the first open day of the workshop - penalty of 50% of the total charge provided that written notice is received.
 - c. Cancellation 30 days or less prior to the first open day of the workshop – 100% of the total charge as a cancellation penalty.
4. In case of cancellations by the organizers, all payments will be reimbursed.
5. Payment must be made in advance of the workshop and is non-refundable according to the above cancellation terms.
